

The Ohio Geological Survey recently released Open-File Report (OFR) 1941-1: The Sharon Coal Mines of Trumbull and Mahoning Counties, which documents the 1941 summer field work of Survey geologists J. Osborn Fuller and Myron T. Sturgeon to locate mine shafts associated with the Sharon coal and Sharon conglomerate. Recently uncovered in the Survey's vast archives, OFR 1941-1 is of practical and historical significance for the mapping of abandoned underground mines (AUMs) throughout Ohio. Featuring descriptions and locations of over 150 mines and mine drains, five 15-minute topographic maps, and 19 photos documented during Fuller and Sturgeon's summer field work, the report can be used to show changes in the regional landscape since that time and to assist with mine subsidence investigations.

Local and regional officials, engineers, and citizens in the region also will find OFR 1941-1 to be an invaluable tool for land planning, construction activities, accurately locating mines, remediation of acid mine drainage sites, and with abandoned-mine land reclamation.
