2019-2020 Application for Scholarship for Member's Children and Student Members

The Ohio Geological Society (OGS) is sponsoring a scholarship for the upcoming academic year (2019-2020). This award is for \$1,500.00. The award will be determined by the OGS Scholarship Committee and announced at the May 2019 meeting of the Society. The award will be paid directly to the student, not to the educational institution. These are one year awards, and will not be automatically renewed; however, the student may apply for any subsequent year's OGS Scholarship as they are announced.

Eligibility Requirements

Any scholarship awarded by the Ohio Geological Society is contingent upon the following conditions. The successful candidates must be accepted at or enrolled in a full time undergraduate studies program at an accredited College or University for the 2019-2020 year. They must be the biological or adopted children or grandchildren of current OGS members who have been a member for at least two of the previous five years, or be a current Student Member of the Society (one of the two Awards). To be considered for the award, applications must be complete and meet the conditions as specified within this application, including all of the information on the Identification/Qualification page.

Confidentiality

All information requested and provided in this application will be kept strictly confidential and not shared with anyone outside the Scholarship Committee process for any other purposes. The Application process includes a step to insure the anonymity of the applicant during the evaluation by the Committee.

A valid application includes **all** of the following:

- A completed Identification/Qualification Information page
- Completion of the Evaluation Information pages by Applicant (and Sponsoring Member, if applicable).
- Essay submission
- Letter of Recommendation
- Copies of requested test and/or and grade information

Please type or print all information. If additional space is needed, attach supplementary pages.

The Letter of Recommendation should be from your High School Adviser (or one of your High School Science Teachers) for a High School Senior, or a Letter of Recommendation from one of your College Science Professors or Instructors, if already in college.

For the following information, please enclose a copy of the following with the application:

- An official transcript from your High School, If not already attending college, **OR**
- The most recently available grade report (transcript) if already in college.
- Score and percentile for ACT or SAT.

This year's (2019-2020) Essay Topic is:

Given: Increased petroleum production in the United States has resulted in lower prices for gasoline and other products. Is this a positive or a negative for the petroleum industry in Ohio and the United States in general? Please give at least one or more positive and one or more negative aspect, and explain why (in your opinion) you think the positive or the negative aspect(s) outweigh the other. There is no right or wrong conclusion. Just support your opinion.

This essay should be limited to a maximum of 350 words.
